

# **Our Club**

- One club known as the "Tigers"
- Blasters, Community, Premier District, Premier Senior
- We are one of 2 clubs in the WACA Competition that caters for Blasters through to Senior Premier Cricket.
- Over 600 members
  - 75 adult members
  - 120 Blasters, 360 Junior Community cricket players
  - 85 Junior Premier (District) players
  - 38 Junior teams (34 Community + 4 Premier)
  - Girls Under 11's, 13's & U15's Teams
- The clubs home grounds are Cresswell Park Swanbourne and Melvista Oval in Nedlands
  - CNCC utilise Council grounds in Town of Claremont, City of Nedlands, Town of Mosman Park, City of Subiaco and some private schools in the western suburbs.

- Run by the Central Junior Cricket Association (CJCA)
- CJCA is governed by CJCC (not the WACA)
- U10s through to U17s for boys
- U11s, U13s, U15s for girls
- Increasing participation by girls is a key objective for CNCC
- Focus is on player participation, having fun and enjoyment
- ALL PLAYERS must get an equal go it's not just about winning!
- Community cricket provides the foundation for those who wish to play higher level Premier (District) cricket from U13s onwards

  - Stage 2 U12s & U13s boys, U15s girls
  - Stage 3 U14s, U15s & U16s/17s boys
- Rules that create angst:
  - LBW
  - Wides
  - No balls
  - Stumpings
  - Rotations
  - Weather-related issues
  - Batting AND bowling rotations







## Spirit of The Game

- No sledging sledging is "anything negative said on a field which a player hears". Association will suspend players for sledging.
- Disputes with opposition teams act reasonably and try to sort it out.
- Benefit of the doubt rests with batsman: LBW, catches, run outs, stumpings etc
- Please apply the spirit of the game in all aspects of play. This includes coaches, umpires, parents, children.
